Post Study Prospects in Qatar

According to the Embassy of India in Qatar the Post Study prospects in Qatar are as follows:

Some universities offer student employment programs which are designed to help students gain real work experience while studying. Most students can work in these programs for up to 20 hours per week. However, foreign students can't work off-campus on a student visa. This requires a separate work visa. Only after graduation, undergraduate and graduate students can transfer their residence permit from the University to the father/brother/husband (personal sponsor) or to a company. For this the student would be required to contact the Scholarship and International Admissions Section of the concerned University directly.

For some programmes of studies, e.g. students in the Arabic for Non-Native Speaker Program (ANNS) under Qatar University are not allowed to transfer their Residence Permit after graduation and must cancel their resident permit and travel out of the country after the graduation ceremony.

The above information is broader in nature and different universities offer different facilities. Students would be required to refer the relevant website of the concerned university for such information.
